The 17th Annual Meeting of the European PhD Network in "Insect Science" will take place from the afternoon of Wednesday, November 18, to noon on Friday, November 20, 2026.

This international event is a well-established tradition for doctoral and post-doctoral researchers in entomology and related disciplines. It is organized by the Società Entomologica Italiana (SEI), the Accademia Nazionale Italiana di Entomologia (ANIE), and the Council for Agricultural Research and Economics - Research Centre for Plant Protection and Certification (CREA).

The meeting will be held in person at the "Aula Zocchi" Auditorium, located at CREA – Research Centre for Plant Protection and Certification, Via Lanciola 12/a, Cascine del Riccio, Firenze.

Sessions will be organized based on the abstracts submitted, reflecting a wide array of topics within insect science. Each participant is invited to present the results of their research - whether planned or in progress - through:

- Regular oral presentations (10–15 minutes, depending on the number of speakers), or
- Short talks (3–5 minutes).

The deadline for abstract submission is October 22, 2026.

Participation is limited to 80 attendees, based on the capacity of the "Aula Zocchi" meeting room. In the case of over-registration, places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

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RULES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF ABSTRACTS

REGULAR AND SHORT PRESENTATION

Abstracts for both regular and short oral presentations must be submitted as a Microsoft Word file (.doc or .docx) by **October 22, 2026**, via email to marina.morra@eventplanetgroup.com.

The file name must correspond to the surname of the first author.

Please ensure that your abstract fully complies with the formatting guidelines below. Only abstracts that adhere to these requirements will be considered for acceptance and inclusion in the scientific program.

Please prepare your abstract according to the following guidelines:

- **Page format:** A4, Calibri font
- **Title (first line):**
 - Calibri, 14 pt, bold, centered
- **Second line:**
 - Leave blank
- **Authors (third line):**
 - Initial of the first name followed by the surname (e.g., **J. Smith**)
 - If there are multiple authors and/or different affiliations, indicate affiliations using superscript numbers after each author's surname (e.g., **J. Smith¹, A. Rossi²**)
 - Underline the name of the corresponding author
 - Calibri, 14 pt, left-aligned
- **Affiliations (fourth line):**
 - Indicate the corresponding superscript number, followed by the institution, department (if applicable), and country
 - Format: **Xxxx University – Department, Country**
 - Calibri, 12 pt, italic, left-aligned
 - Separate multiple affiliations with semicolons
 - Do not include email addresses or postal addresses
- **Fifth line:**
 - Leave blank
- **Abstract text:**
 - Calibri, 12 pt, justified
 - No first-line indentation
 - No spacing between paragraphs
 - Maximum length: **250 words**
 - Do not include section headings, references, undefined abbreviations, tables, figures, or images
